Water and Sewer Rate Increases, Storm Water Management

Water and Sewer Rate Increases

History

Prior to tonight's meeting, the Village Trustees have been given a copy of our last water rate study and an update of that study for the next budget year. The bottom line is that if we do not increase our rates, we will have an OPERATING DEFICIT.

The Baxter & Woodman, Inc. report determined that out of five proposed rate options, the one we are presently using was the fairest way to apportion fees. Those on fixed incomes are better off because the service charge was kept low and we have no minimum usage.

We have also done a survey this week on utility rates charged by surrounding communities. The results clearly show that our requested rate increases are reasonable.

I move to recommend to the Board to increase the water and sewer rates as recommended by staff to a total of \$2.55/I,000 gallons incorporated and \$4.20/1,000 gallons for unincorporated.

Recommended Action/Motion

I move to increase the water rate for residents from \$2.00 to \$2.15 per 1,000 gallons, the sewer rate from 34 cents to 35 cents per 1,000 gallons, and to add a Storm Water rate of 5 cents per 1,000 gallons;

and

To increase water rates for non-residents from \$3.45 to \$3.70, the sewer rate from 43 cents to 45 cents, and to add a Storm water rate of 5 cents per 1,000 gallons;

and

That staff is directed to study the method of assessing the sewer rate by ascertaining what other communities do and come back to the Board with a recommendation as to alternative methods of charging for sewer that will accommodate watering during the summer.
